

Hand Hygiene at MICs Group of Health Services

MICs Group of Health Services is launching the “Just Clean Your Hands” program at all MICs facilities with the goal of improving Hand Hygiene compliance by all health care providers. The performance of hand hygiene is key to improving patient and health care provider safety, and to preventing health care associated infections and the spread of antibiotic resistant organisms. Health care associated infections can make people sick, lead to longer hospital stays and re-admissions. Hand hygiene should always be performed by health care providers before and after each patient contact.

In order to evaluate the program’s impact and measure our progress we are auditing hand hygiene by our health care workers. You can view the results of our baseline rates in the table below. Our rates will reflect percent compliance before and after patient contact. Hand Hygiene compliance rates for each MICs facility will be posted annually. Our success will be measured by steady improvement in compliance rates.
