Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) (<u>www.werpn.com</u>)

If providing care and helping to improve the lives of others is your passion, consider a career in nursing. In Ontario, nursing is one profession with two categories: **Registered Practical Nurse (RPN)** and Registered Nurse (RN). RPNs are health care professionals—they combine nursing skill, knowledge and judgment and are experts of nursing care at the bedside. At MICs, RPNs work in acute, emergency, complex continuing care, long-term care, telemedicine, diabetes, pharmacy, and specialty clinics.

Education Requirements:

RPNs are community college graduates. After graduation, they write a national certification examination. Once they successfully complete this exam, they are registered to practice as a nurse by the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO). All nurses must renew their CNO registration annually, maintaining up-to-date skills and knowledge of current practices, to preserve their professional standing.

To become a Registered Practical Nurse you require an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) which includes Grade 12 english, math and biology plus one science (chemistry or physics)
